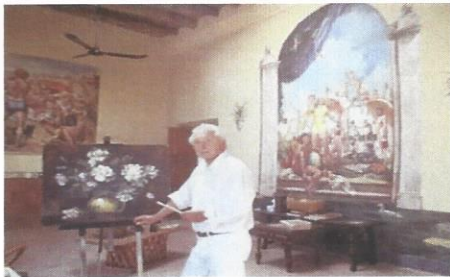

The gentleman shown in the photograph created our lobby murals, "Birth of Hawaii" and "Arrival of Kamehameha." H.D. "Doug" Riseborough, a Canadian, came to the

U.S. in 1946 where he studied and worked in Los Angeles. He was largely self-taught and used acrylic lacquer. By 1967, the date of our murals, he had produced murals for the 1961 World's Fair and Rockefeller Center as well as for the Royal Family of Saudi Arabia. Another Hawaii commission was the four stories high "Birth of Maui" for the Grand Wailea Resort. Recently he has been working in Mexico. Perhaps our buildings will be designated as a historic site.
