Projects under way:

Kehaulani Masonry is re-doing the walkway by building 4.

The chillers are being retrofitted to help with energy and efficiency of A/C system.

The elevators are repaired (indentations and scratches removed) and cleaned.

Cameras and the security system are being repaired and necessary parts will be replaced.
